Operating Instructions

Casement and Awning Windows

- Turn operator handle clockwise to open window.
- Turn operator handle counter-clockwise to close window. Make sure you feel resistance on the handle. DO NOT keep turning handle after you feel resistance to avoid damaging operating hardware.
- Press down on lock, so that the lock will pull the sash in to the frame. Make sure the sash is pulled in tightly to the frame.
- Do not force the handle, as that will damage the operating hardware.
- Before opening the window, make sure the locks are in the open position.
- For multipoint locking, press down on the lever to place it into the locked position.

Single Sliders and Double Sliders

- To ensure proper functionality, the tracks must be clean of dirt and debris.
- To ensure rollers are clean, lift out the sash (single slider) or tilt the sash (double slider) to view rollers.
- IMPORTANT FOR DOUBLE SLIDER Before tilting sash, please slide sash by 1 inch, past the side frames to prevent damage.
- Ensure the exterior drainage holes are clear of dirt and debris.
- To open, unlock lock and pull sash until window is open.
- To close, push sash into frame until it is tightly fitted.

Single Hung and Double Hung

- Bottom sill must be kept clean.
- Raise sash 1 inch from the bottom edge of the window. Tilt inward to clean. This prevents damage to frame.
- Ensure the exterior drainage holes are clear of dirt and debris.
- To open, unlock lock and push sash upward until window is open.
- To close, pull sash downward until window is tightly fitted into frame.
